General Enrollment Policy

The 91st Psalm Christian School recognizes that it cannot meet the educational needs of all children. It is a school offering a high quality of Christian training, but it is not designed to be a correctional institution for problems arising beyond those usually encountered in average school children. While we love all children, the school is not equipped to meet all special needs. Some children do not adjust to a disciplined academic environment and the school reserves the right to have full discretion to place such students on probation for a reasonable corrective period of time and to dismiss any student who does not cooperate with the total educational process.

All new students are admitted on a probationary basis for the first year. When on probation, a student can be dismissed at any time if it is in the best interest of the school to do so. Initials_____
