The State of Arizona does not accredit or require this school to be accredited. Our course, curriculum and graduation requirements exceed the minimum requirements of the Arizona State Board of Education. The 91st Psalm Christian School is a not for profit school and a ministry of SouthGate Church. As a nonprofit institution, the school is not required to be accredited by the State of Arizona or any other agency.

The school was established in 1984 and has graduates that have attended and graduated from Arizona State University, University of Arizona, Northern Arizona University, Grand Canyon University, Mesa Community College, and South Mountain Community College. The graduate list includes doctors, engineers, teachers, missionaries, businessmen and women, etc.

Our secondary staff has bachelors, masters or doctorate degrees from public institutions. The staff is teacher certifiable and the public school districts and Arizona State University have employed the Instructional Supervisors as teacher trainers and curriculum development specialists.

Be aware that even though our twenty plus years of educating students, has contributed toward the education of doctors, teachers, businessmen and women, ministers and much more, the credits earned by students here at the high school level are not always accepted by the public high school system. Should you decide to transfer your high school student to another school during their high school years, that school is not required to accept the credits your high school student earned while attending the 91st Psalm Christian School.
